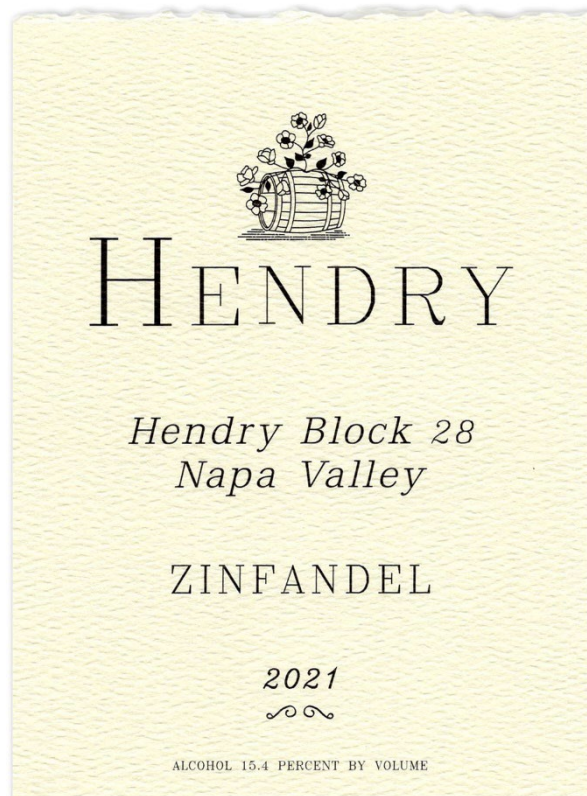


HENDRY 2021
BLOCK 28 ZINFANDEL
NAPA VALLEY



Another remarkable vineyard in Napa Valley that made this week's report is the Hendry Estate, which borders the city of Napa on the northwest and is essentially wedged between the Carneros and Oak Knoll AVAs. The family seems to be able to succeed with every popular grape variety. Check out the good scores and great notes for their chardonnays, cabernet sauvignons, pinot noirs and zinfandels.

Aromas of blueberry tart, poached rhubarb, cigar box and sweet spices. The palate is full-bodied with firm yet integrated tannins, bright acidity and notes of black cherries, baking spices and burnt oranges. Block 28 sits at 60 meters above sea level and is planted to St. George rootstock. The wine is aged for 15 months in 65% new oak. A powerful and tightly bound wine that will age gracefully. Drink or hold.

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
