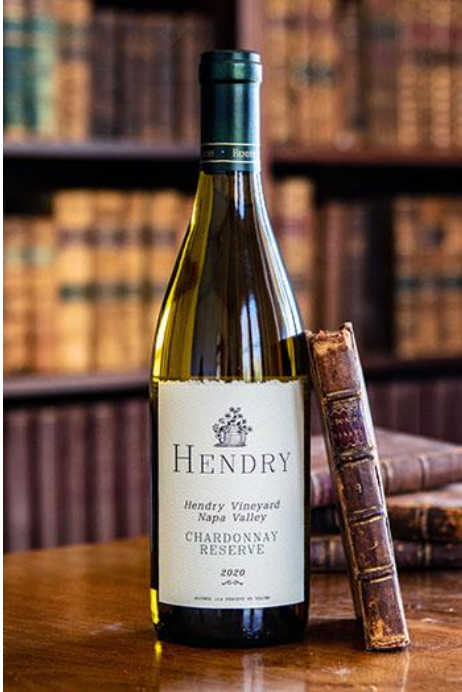




HENDRY RESERVE WINES



Chardonnay Reserve

- Vineyard Source: Block 9
- Planted 1974
- KD/Old Wente selection, St. George roots
- Winemaking: Individual press fractions selected at harvest
- Fermentation in barrel
- 12 months *sur lie* aging
- 100% new French oak cooperage
- bi-weekly *battonage*.
- Profile: layered, complex, creamy and elegant, with potential for long-term aging.



Cabernet Sauvignon Reserve

- Vineyard Source: Block 8D and 8F
- Planted in 1974
- FPMS Clone 7, St. George roots
- Southern side of blocks only
- Winemaking:
- 18 barrels made
- 100% new French oak
- 100% Taransaud cooperage
- 24 months in barrel, unfinned
- Profile: Opaque, inky deep ruby color. Deep berry with a whiff of eucalyptus, and briary, dry-leaf aromas. Layered and complex, this wine will certainly reveal more of its charms with time, but it has elegance, and a flow on the palate that is already intriguing. We encourage you to decant.
