### HENDRY

**HENDRY is an old-school, under-the-radar gem that delights without a grand château** or pomp and circumstance. The ranch at the base of Mount Veeder, which today includes 114 acres planted, dates to 1859 and has been under the Hendry family’s stewardship since 1939.

**The vibe is intimate and casual**, with tastings hosted on a porch or inside a simple farmhouse-style building (from 10 am to 3 pm-ish, by appointment), and it is all about the wine. Hendry’s knowledgeable staff pour a selection of estate-grown wines while sharing details of the family and its history on the ranch. Time a visit right, and you can reserve the “Hike with Hendry” experience, held four times a year and hosted by third-generation farmer and winemaker Mike Hendry, who discusses and demonstrates the seasonal happenings in the vineyard, followed by a tasting flight.

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
